She was a great educator - having been the director of the Buford Highway Baptist Church Kindergarten for several years. She was an enthusiastic mission supporter- alongside her husband and church, encouraging and supporting 75 missionaries around the globe for many years. She was a great encourager - bringing smiles as a clown to many patients as she visited room by room at Joan Glancy Hospital for ten years. She was a great artist -having her own ceramic shop for ten years, and

then later designing and making thousands of greeting cards over the past 26 years. The family will receive friends at Flanigan Funeral Home from 5-8 p.m. on Saturday, November 2.
