Albert M. Reusing, Jr., 78 years old, of Braselton, Georgia, passed away Monday, June 9, 2014. He was born in Reading, Pennsylvania on July 1, 1935 to the late Marie Tolland Reusing and Albert M. Reusing, Sr. In 1956, he moved to Atlanta to attend Georgia Institute of Technology to study aeronautical engineering. He financed his college education by working at Lockheed Martin in Marietta, Georgia. He later served in the US Army in Korea. In 1968, Bert opened Tucker Data Services. He was on the cutting edge of numerical controlled programming which produced parts for the aerospace industry. He was a key vendor for Lockheed while working on the F-22 Aircraft. Bert was an enthusiastic supporter of Georgia Tech athletics and an avid golfer.

He is survived by his loving wife of 42 years, Donna Zapp Reusing; son, William M. Reusing; daughter, Erin Reusing Spector; grandson, J. Owen Spector; granddaughter, Ellery L.
