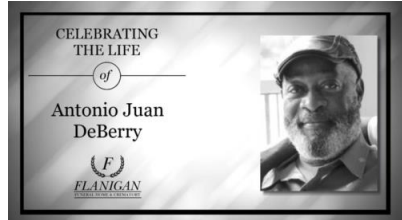

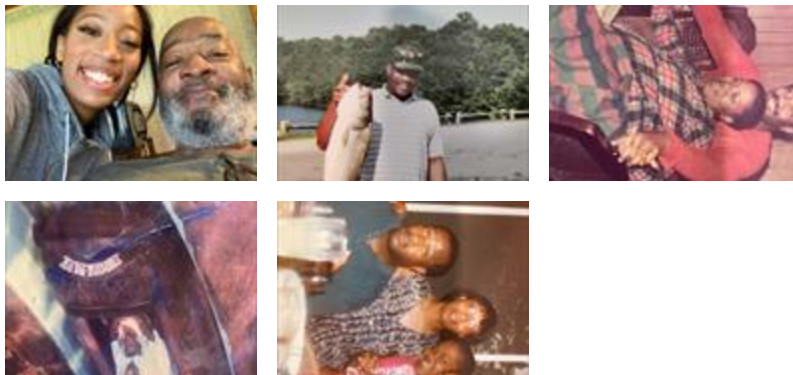
I pray for strength, comfort and healing throughout this difficult time for the DeBerry family and everyone who's life Tony touched. I will always miss you Tony.

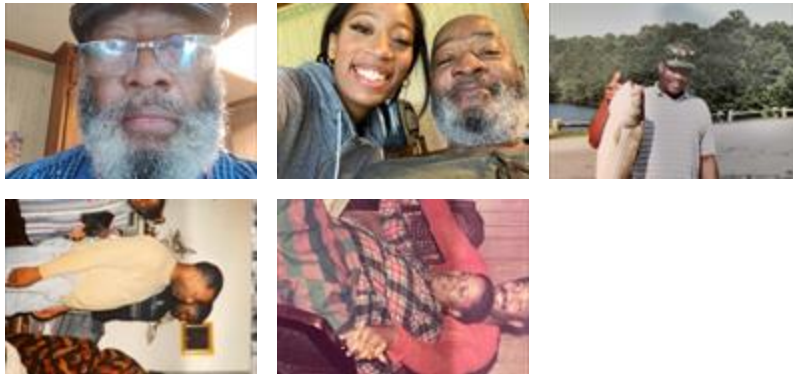
