His dedication on the field was matched only by his kindness and humility off of it. He carried himself with quiet confidence, always striving to uplift others and lead by example.

He valued family, friendship, and community, and he touched countless lives through his generosity of spirit. Those who knew him will remember his warm presence, his steady determination, and the pride he took in every endeavor.
