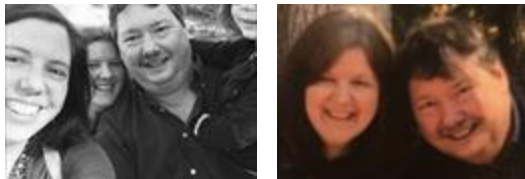
“ *Brett was one of my best friends. We met in business and actually worked together during the last part of my career. He was a good business person and negotiator.*
