Carolyn Elizabeth Lane, nee Brooks, collapsed in her home and died a short while later at 11:41 PM on Friday, February 7, 2014 at the Gwinnett Medical Center, Lawrenceville, GA. Carol was 65 years of age.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, Carol, over her adult life, made her home in Millersville, PA, Mt. Pleasant, MI, Cincinnati, OH, Stone Mountain, GA and Dacula, GA.

Carol was survived by her mother, Isabel A. Brooks, 94, of Lancaster, PA, Brett A. Palmquist, 26, of Dacula, GA, Suzanne E. Zartman, 55, of Antwerp, OH, and Leslie (Lee) M. Brooks, Jr., 62, of Akron, PA.

Carol graduated from Millersville University in 1970 with a BS in Education. A few years later, she completed a Master of Education/Reading Specialist degree at Xavier University. And in 1993, Carol completed an Ed.S. program in School Counseling at The University of Georgia. Throughout her 41-year career in the field of education, she taught English, Reading and served as a school counselor.

Although she officially retired in the Spring of 2013, Carol had continued teaching and counseling, this time, adult students close to the completion of ESL and GED degrees. Prior to that, Carol's longest stint was at her beloved Crews Middle School in Lawrenceville, GA where she served as a guidance counselor. She greatly loved the privilege of providing any possible help to the

students there.
