Mrs. Cecilia Cleland Dasher (the former Cecilia Margaret Cleland), originally of Carlisle, England died Friday, June 15, 2018. She was born in Matanzas, Cuba on September 4, 1922.

Mrs. Dasher and her parents, Matthew Cleland of Glasgow, Scotland and Florence Pearson Cleland of Carlisle were émigrés to and became citizens of the United States post World War II. The Clelands lived in Atlanta where Cecilia met her future husband of 62 years, Troy Marquis Dasher, Jr. who preceded her in death.
