Clyde Duensing Jr. was born on March 11, 1938 in Jacksonville, Florida, the only child of Clyde and Jewell Duensing. In 1956, at the age of 18, he married his high school sweetheart, Winnie Main.

Skilled in many areas of endeavor, he alternately worked as an electrical engineer, a building contractor, and an auto mechanic.

He maintained a lifelong passion for racing, auto work and classic cars. In his youth, he entered local events, but in later years participated from his recliner as a NASCAR fan.

He loved photography and videography, and documented much of his life and the activities of his family and church on film and tape.

A dedicated husband, father and grandfather, he was also devoted to his church, to which he donated many hours of construction and maintenance work, and to his community in Flagler Beach, FL, where he served for years as city commissioner, city manager, building inspector and advisor to the county school board.

Clyde moved to Buford, Georgia in August of 2021, and passed on January 6, 2022, his sweetheart still at his side. He is survived by his wife, Winnie, two

sons and six grandchildren.
