Donald John Mossbrooks, age 87, of Lawrenceville, GA formerly of Norcross, GA and Rochester, NY, passed away Monday, March 27, 2017 after a multiple-year battle with Cancer. He is survived by his children, his son, Scott and Eileen Mossbrooks of Flowery Branch, GA, and his daughter, Sharyll Mossbrooks of Lawrenceville, GA; and several brothers-in-law, nieces, nephews and cousins.

Mr. Mossbrooks was born on May 30, 1929 in Rochester, New York. He was a graduate of St. Thomas Aquinas High School in Rochester. During his career at Eastman Kodak Company, Donald worked his way up through the ranks, becoming one of their top Industrial Engineers. It was a promotion at Kodak, in March of 1969, that took Donald and his family from Rochester to Norcross, GA where he worked at the Chamblee, GA location. Donald was very active in his churches, serving as an acolyte warden and on the vestries at both Holy Innocents Episcopal Church in Atlanta, GA and St. Mary & Martha of Bethany in Buford, GA.

Mr. Mossbrooks was always a fierce competitor who really enjoyed league bowling, coaching his children in sports and in life, being active in the community, supporting great causes for children, music, pets, collected gems and did Lapidary work. Donald was also very big into the Atlanta Falcons, Fishing, Jazz and Classic Cars, passing his love of these onto his children. Until his health turned, Don was an avid supporter and season ticket holder for the Gwinnett Gladiators.
