Doreen was a woman of immense faith. She was in church nearly every Sunday. In her youth she was extremely active at Holy Cross Catholic Church. She was heavily involved in the teen youth group, the choir and participated and supported in the church theater group. Later in life she and her family moved to St. John Neumann where she taught seven years of PSR. She loved the Lord so much and wanted to spread his word, that she taught so

many children and helped strengthen not only her faith, but their faith. After she moved to Sugar Hill, GA, she loved going to Mass every Saturday at St. Benedicts in John's Creek.

Doreen was a fabulous cook and the family baker. At any event, she would have baked several platters of goodies and desserts. Especially at Christmas time. Doreen would spend days baking, icing, sorting, and then assembling a variety of cookies, brownies as well as other baked goods into trays. These would be given as gifts made with love that would also become a staple of every holiday gathering that generations of her family loved and continued to request. These trays have become a Towhey/Basile family holiday tradition that once done by one woman will now take a family to keep alive.

Doreen put so much love in all that she did. When she discovered something, she learned everything she could about it and then would teach everyone else. Especially games. Card games, pickleball, trivia. Doreen loved to be the hostess with the mostest. She always payed attention to the finite details to everything and made sure everyone had a great time. Helping others gave her such joy. She was proud to be an advocate for those in need, she was an angel on this earth.

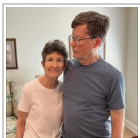
