Dottie Parrott (born Dorotha N. Goss), age 86 of Buford, GA passed away on Dec 2, 2025 at 1:20 in the afternoon. She drifted quietly from this life into Heaven while her loving and devoted husband, Virgil Parrott, of 67 years held her hand.

She came into this world as the youngest of 3 children on February 15, 1939 in Jasper, GA.

She was preceded in death by her faithful and doting parents David "Pope" Goss, Sr. and Johnnie Mae (Cantrell) Goss, of GA and MI.

After the first 12 years of her life were spent growing up in the Blue Ridge Mountains of GA, her father relocated the family to Michigan for his long-standing career with Ford Motors.

Shortly after Dottie graduated from Roosevelt High School, she was attending her home church of Gilead Baptist Church for a youth fish fry.
