Dr. George Melvin Page, Jr., age 61, of Flowery Branch, GA passed away on Sunday, November 6, 2011. He was preceded in death by his parents, George M. Page, Sr. and Betty Darby Page. He is survived by his wife of thirty years, Carolyn Brown Page, Flowery Branch, GA; sons, Ben Page and Josh Page; grandsons, Brayden Page and Dylan Page; step mother, Myrt Page, Vidalia, GA; sister and brother-in-law, Rose Anne and Howard Holman, Vidalia, GA; father-in-law and mother-in-law, Kenneth and Marie Brown, Trenton, TN; brothers-in-law and sister-in-law, Ricky and Patty Brown and Jim Brown; sisters-in-law and brothers-in-law, Linda and Mark Davis and Lisa and Dean Corley; and several nieces, nephews and cousins. Dr. Page graduated from Kansas City School of Osteopathy in Kansas City, KS in 1979. He moved to the Buford area where he maintained a family medical practice in Buford from 1981 until he retired in 1997. He was the first Doctor of Osteopathy to be granted medical privileges at Gwinnett Hospital System. He was an attending physician at the former Buford Manor Nursing Home. He was one of the founders and was currently one of the board members of the People's Bank of Buford. Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, November 9, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. in the Chapel of Flanigan Funeral Home.
