She played the piano and the flute and she loved to sing. She had a gift for finding inspiring books and music and sharing her discoveries with others. Her life was shaped in every way by her faith in God. This genuine faith was revealed in her conversation, in her prayer life, in her art and the love she showered on everyone she met. She always sought to use her talents for God's glory.

Esther was diagnosed with cancer in 2007. Throughout the ups and downs of her struggle against the disease Esther was sustained by her deep faith and love of God. She maintained an amazing buoyancy of spirit and never failed offer friends and loved ones her gentle presence, kind words and her beautiful smile.
