Fannie Lou worked for the Nabisco Company for 44.5 years. She was very proud of her work and had many close friends there. She did the hard factory work to support her 3 children providing them with everything they needed.

Fannie Lou attended Buford High School and was crowned Miss Buford in 1947, the first year the pageant was held. Over the years Buford High School graciously allowed former beauty pageant winners to be part of the ceremony. She enjoyed attending these contests.

Fannie Lou was predeceased by her father, Clayton Garner and mother, Alma Garner, two sisters, Helen and Ruth Garner, her brother Coleman Garner, her first husband, Pete Hope and her second husband, Wesley Anderson.

Fannie Lou is survived by her three children, Ted Hope (Joyce), Ray Hope, Jenny Hope Roach (Barry), and two grandchildren Shane Hope (Kiley), and Matthew Roach; first cousins, Regina Marshall and Laverne Kerlin. Numerous other cousins also survive.
