Jack "Frosty" Grizzle, age 66, of Sugar Hill, GA passed away on September 30, 2020. He served at Camp Lejune, NC, Quantico, VA, and San Juan Puerto Rico, serving at different marine bases along the way. He was awarded a Sharp Shooter medal and a Meritorious Mast for outstanding service during April 1974 to March 1975. Mr. Grizzle was a Lance Corporal in the military, and he was discharged as a Sergeant. He went on later to serve in the Marine Corp Reserves. Mr. Grizzle was a millrite in his welding career. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Buford, GA and a member of Buford American Legion Post 127 for forty-two years. 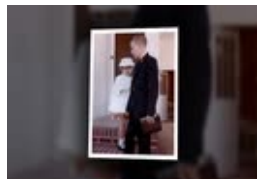
