Jim, 74 year old resident of Flowery Branch, Georgia met his Lord and Savior Saturday, November 24 with his family by his side. Born to Mr. and Mrs. James K. Kelley, Jr. in Ocala, Florida on October 30, 1944, Jim spent his childhood in Martel, Inverness, and Ocala before graduating from Ocala High School in 1962. He married Teresa Daniel in 1964 while attending the University of Florida. Jim joined the United States Navy as part of the "Seabees" and proudly served two tours in Vietnam. Upon return from service he graduated from the University of Florida, School of Building Construction in 1971. He became the proud father of James K. Kelley, IV and Heather D. Kelley. Jim worked with Allen Trovillion Construction in Winter Park, Florida before partnering with long time friend Ted Douglas in Gainesville, Florida to form Douglas and Kelley, Inc. The family relocated to Brandon, Florida in 1985. Jim continued his career in construction and was a dedicated leader in the youth group of the First Baptist Church. He served as counselor, confidant, and role model to many during this time. He and Teresa moved to Lawrenceville, Georgia in 2006 to be near their 5 grandchildren and finally retired to Flowery Branch, Georgia in 2016. Jim is preceded in death by his parents James K.
