Jim is survived by one sister, Mary Manley Allen, of Granbury, TX. He was an exceptional father to two sons: Scott (Cindi) Manley, of Roswell, GA, and Philip (Julie) Manley, of Auburn, GA. He married in 1951 and began his long career in the insurance field with Federated Mutual Insurance Company. He would eventually retire as an executive with Chubb Insurance in 1990. His retirement was spent with his beloved grandchildren, and traveling with Jeanette upon her retirement. The Manley's were always faithful church members in any community in which they lived in the metro Atlanta area.
