Landon "David" Chambers III, age 66, died at his home in Alpharetta, Georgia after a short illness with pancreatic cancer.

David was born and raised in Elizabethton, Tennessee. He was the son of the late Martha Thomas Chambers and the late L. D. Chambers Jr. He graduated from Elizabethton High School and attended East Tennessee State University and Lincoln Memorial University. He served in the United States Army in Germany and Korea in the late 1960's. He had an accomplished career as a construction superintendent in commercial building and restoration in Charlotte, NC, Orlando and Lake Worth, Florida.
