Leila Goss Liuzza, age 55 of Atlanta, passed away unexpectedly at St. Joseph's Hospital in Atlanta on August 26, 2014. She was born on October 10, 1958.

A devoted wife and mother, she had served professionally as a Registered Nurse and had lived in Atlanta for many years. She is survived by her husband, Steve Paul Liuzza Jr. of Atlanta, and one son, Anthony Liuzza of North Carolina.

Other survivors include her mother, Lillian Weaver Aylwin, and a sister Lillian Aylwin Dickson, both of California; brothers Hilton Carpenter Goss and Glen Fullerton Goss, both of Florida; and a step-sister Lynne Aylwin Davis of Florida.
