Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, December 12, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. at Sugar Hill Baptist Church Chapel with Rev. Neil Strong and Rev. Ron Guess officiating. The remains will be placed in state at the church at 12:00 noon. Interment will follow the service at Broadlawn Memorial Gardens in Buford, GA. Rev. Wayne Johnson will officiate at the graveside service.
