Mateo Estacion Caymol, "Matt", 75, previously of Goose Creek, SC, passed away peacefully at Embracing Care Hospice, near his current home in Suwanee, GA, at 10:25pm on Monday, October 6, after a valiant fight against lung cancer. "Matt", as his friends called him, was born on Sept 30, 1939, in Cavite City, Philippines. He was the youngest of 5 children to Ramon Sr. and Basilia Estacion Caymol. Matt joined the US Navy at age 17, where he served this country for 28 years. He was a highly decorated soldier and received many commendations. Among those were The National Defense Service Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal, the Vietnam Campaign Medal, the Combat Action Ribbon, Meritorious Unit Commendation, Battle "E" (two awards), Navy Commendation Medal, the Sixth Good Conduct Award, Sea Service Deployment Ribbon, the Navy Achievement Medal and the distinguished Navy Silver Star. He finished his distinguished career in the Navy as a multi-award winning US Navy Recruiter, and was twice named "Recruiter of the Year". Matt also enjoyed being a member of the American Legion of Buford, the American Legion of Goose Creek and was a member of the Filipino-American Masons.

Above all of his medals, certificates, commendations and awards, he considered his greatest achievement his family. He spent many hours talking about his grandchildren to anyone who would listen. Matt is survived by his wife, Carolyn Church Caymol, his daughter Angela (Rick) Schuckle, daughter
