A special group, Blue Skies Ministry allowed the family to attend beach retreats for many years at Port St. Joe, Florida and these trips were a slice of Heaven to her each time she attended.

She loved hard and big. Monica was a member of Bethlehem Church where she has served in the children's program for over ten years. She loved watching over all the little ones. Monica was a talented makeup artist, incredible artist that loved to draw and paint, as well as a talented seamstress that created from scratch many outfits for herself to wear at COSplay conventions and hospital princess events over the years.

Monica has always loved being a big sister to her brothers Bubba and Cody. They shared a lot of laughs together and created many memories that will never be forgotten. Monica was loved so, so much by Jeannie and Victor and the family will never forget how I love you more than me.

Monica was a member of the class of 2013 at West Hall High School.

She will be surrounded by those she loved that went before her and be totally free from pain and suffering after 12 long, hard years.

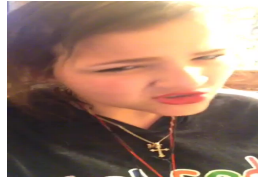
