Clarence Allen "CR" Roberts passed away on January 8, 2016. He was born on September 15, 1938 in Columbus, GA. CR graduated from Auburn University and was a Sigma Nu. After serving in the Army Reserves as a medic for seven years, Clarence dedicated his career to the wood products industry and gave many years of service to US Plywood, Jim Walter Homes, Masonite and International Paper.
