Nicholas Bryant Puckett, 34, of Pendergrass, GA died Friday, June 23, 2023 in Houston, TX after a battle with cancer.

Born April 10, 1989, in Gwinnett, GA, Nick grew up in the area and graduated from North Gwinnett High School, class of 2008. Nick lived to serve and was happiest when he could help or do for those he loved. His positivity and genuine care for others were his trademark that led to lifelong friendships. He was known to always go the extra mile, whether at work or helping a friend and never said “no” to a project.
