Patricia Ann Treutle, age 59, peacefully passed away February 21, 2013 at her home in Flowery Branch, GA, after an arduous battle with cancer. Patricia was born August 6, 1953, in Lacon, Illinois, the daughter of Donald Eugene Westefer and Evelyn Lucille Durst.

Patty attended Mid County High School in Lacon, Illinois, before attending Northern Illinois University in Dekalb, Illinois, where she graduated with honors. Later in life, Patricia furthered her education by receiving a Master of Art's Degree and consecutively earning an Education Specialist Degree from Piedmont University. To say she was an "overachiever" is putting it mildly.

In 1983, Patricia graduated from the police academy in Ft. Lauderdale, FL where she served as Police officer and detective for 13 years before retiring and finding the love of her life, Steven Harold Treutle, who was a detective with FLPD as well. Upon retiring from the Police Department, Patricia and Steve moved to Illinois and subsequently Georgia, where Patty taught math and English at Buford High School and Buford Middle School for 12 years.
