He was also a long-time member of Harmony Baptist Church in Buford, GA. Ray was a former Gwinnett County Policeman and served on the Buford Volunteer Fire Department for a long time. Mr. Sexton and his wife, Charlotte, operated Ray's Crossroad Grocery Store for many years. In his later years, he was "on Staff" at Flanigan Funeral Home in Buford, GA from 2003 to 2019 where he is remembered as a wonderful worker. Ray was a Mason and member of Buford Masonic Lodge 292 F. & A.M., member of Royal Arch, Taylor Chapter, No. 48. He was a Shriner and member of Yarrab Temple in

Atlanta. He recently received his 60 year pin from Buford Masonic Lodge 292. Ray and Charlotte enjoyed camping along with bluegrass music as they traveled far and near. 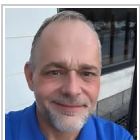
