Robert Joseph Corr, 83, of Flowery Branch, GA passed away on Friday morning, February 16, 2018. He was born on August 17, 1934 in Pittsburgh, PA to the late Patrick Joseph and Elizabeth Dutney Corr. He went into the Army where he worked as the All Army team coach training for the Olympics stationed in HI. As a veteran he received a full swimming scholarship to attend the University of Miami. His first job after school was working for Dade County parks and recreation, followed by a twenty year stint with The American Red Cross; where he was a rep for many GA Counties. While there he made Water Safety videos for teaching children and adults to swim that were used in all Red Cross swimming programs. He was also on the disaster relief team and responded to many area floods and hurricanes providing needed aid to those in need. When he retired, he owned and operated two area businesses, B & L E.Z. Stop in Flowery Branch and Cory's Restaurant on Holiday Rd in Buford. He leaves his wife, Lynne and son, Bob. Also sister, Patricia McDonald of Zellwood Station, FL; brothers, William Dutney Corr of Durham, NC, Tom Corr of Cincinnati, OH, and Patrick Corr of Pittsburgh, PA. Robert (better known as "Bob") will be remembered for his love of Lake Lanier and all things connected to it, boating, etc. and teaching the neighborhood children to swim.
