Robert Medvedeff, age 84, of Sugar Hill, GA passed away on Sunday, February 8, 2015. He is survived by his wife of fifty-four years, Anna Guenther Medvedeff; brother and sister-in-law, Phillip Lewis and Arlene Medvedeff, NY; special nieces, Andrea Bernhardt, Venezuela, and Siobhan Bernhardt, Miami, FL; numerous other nieces, nephews and cousins.
