Mr. Ronald Harold Simpson, age 63, of Buford, GA passed away on Wednesday, February 22, 2012. He is survived by his wife of thirty-four years, Nancy R. Simpson, Buford, GA; son and daughter-in-law, Alex and Diane Simpson, Dacula, GA; parents, Harold and Carlotta Simpson, Buford, GA; brother and sister-in-law, Michael and Judy Simpson, Los Angeles, CA; sister-in-law and brother-in-law, Sandra and Chuck Bennett, Baldwin, GA; brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Richard and Marnie Ridlehoover, Laurens, SC; and several nephews and cousins. Mr. Simpson was born January 1, 1949 in Cartersville, GA. He was a 1967 graduate of Forest Park High School and a 1977 graduate of Georgia Institute of Technology where he received his Electrical Engineering Degree. Ronald was a Senior Power Systems Engineer for 33 years, 29 of those years with GE. He made the GE Field Service Engineers "Hall of Fame" in 2005. Among numerous professional awards and accomplishments, he served as the Chair of IEEE/IAS Pulp & Paper Committee in 2003-2004 and was nominated for IEEE Fellow in 2010. Ronald had a great love of music throughout his life. In particular, he had great knowledge of and affection for classic rock. He wrote songs and played and performed in recent years with the band Under Construction, which he formed with friends. He was a member of Hamilton Mill Presbyterian Church in Hoschton, GA. A Celebration of Life Service will be held on Saturday, February 25, 2012 at 2:00 p.m. at Hamilton Mill Presbyterian Church with Rev. Tom Bagley and Rev. Stephen Walters officiating. The family will receive

“ It was obvious to everyone who knew Ronald Simpson in High School that he was a very smart guy. It was also obvious that he was big, tall and handsome. But I've got a story that you probably didn't know and I doubt Ronald ever said anything about. It would not have been like him to talk about such things because after all Ronald was a class act. One afternoon after school Ronald and another very big strong guy decided that a field behind Murphy and Orr in Forest Park, Georgia wasn't big enough for the two of them and they got into the biggest fight I had ever seen. The classic fight of Mohammad Ali and Joe Frazer was four years away but I can tell you that trilogy would have bored you after seeing the Ronald Simpson/ Don Conkle fight. These two boys both over 6 foot tall and 200 lbs. went at it trading blows that would have impressed George Foreman. Neither one would quit and the punishment went on for over an hour. There were no breaks and the only bells they heard that day were the ones going off in their head. There were two things I learned from that fight. One was that Ronald could punch like a mule and the other was that Don Conkle could take a beating like Joe Frazer. Several times Ronald caught Don coming in and I do not understand why Don's head stayed on his shoulders as his feet appeared to leave the ground. Ronald could have made his living as a fighter.

I was so impressed by this encounter that I have told this story a hundred times in my lifetime and so I was surprised when I saw Ronald at one of our High School reunions 40 years later and Ronald appeared to be embarrassed by the whole thing. He just looked at the floor and said it was a stupid thing to do.

He also didn't want to tell me about his accomplishments as an Engineer though I knew there were many. It now appeared that the big guy with the big punch had grown even bigger. Ronald was a class act with his feet planted on higher ground. His family and his church were his priorities and these were the beneficiaries of not only a very fine man but a tough one.
