Ruth P. Owens was born on December 28, 1929 in Muncie, Indiana. She is a graduate of Central High School in Muncie, Indiana; Miami University in Oxford, Ohio; and Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio. Ruth earned AB, MT and MD degrees in microbiology, medical technology and pediatric endocrinology.

As a professor of pediatrics, Dr. Owens was a faculty member at Case Western Reserve School of Medicine in Cleveland, Ohio, and taught microbiology, medical technology and pediatric endocrinology.

A follower of Christ, Ruth worshiped God in the Presbyterian Church and practiced her faith by loving and serving people through good stewardship of her time, treasure and talents. Her avocational interests and hobbies included music, gardening and genealogy.

Through the years of her adult life Ruth resided in Cleveland, Ohio; Denver, Colorado; and Beaufort, South Carolina. She and her sister, Jane, moved to Village East of Lanier Village Estates in 2006. Ruth resided in Apt. #2312. Ruth eventually transitioned to OakBridge Terrace #230, and finally to Willow-

Brooke Court #203-B, where she passed away under hospice care on Sunday, January 14, 2018.

Ruth is preceded by her parents and her two sisters, Jane Southworth of Gainesville, Georgia and Margaret Ehmke of Indianapolis, Indiana. She is survived by three nieces and her nephew, Tom Southworth of Braselton, Georgia.

A Memorial Service for Ruth will be held in the Chapel at Lanier Village Estates on Wednesday, January 31, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. The Rev. Lee Koontz, Senior Pastor at First Presbyterian Church, will officiate with Chaplain Richard Evans of Lanier Village.
