In Loving Memory of Teresa Inez Schlottmann

Teresa Inez Schlottmann (née Lawson), 74, of Sugar Hill, GA, passed away surrounded by her loving family on February 28, 2024—just two days shy of her 75th birthday. Born on March 1, 1949, in Bentonville, Arkansas, to William Henry Lawson and Norma Joyce Lawson (née Wood), Teresa's early years in Littlerock, Arkansas, and later in Grandview, Washington, shaped a life rich in faith, family, and community.

On March 29, 1969, she married John Daniel Schlottmann, with whom she shared a profound journey of love and partnership until his passing. Their union was blessed with four children: Brian Henri, Candra Joyce, Krystal Kay, and Daniel Clayton, who, along with her grandchildren—Matthew, Julian, Keely, Collin, Cooper, Ansley, AmeliaJohn, and Samuel—were the joy of her life. She was particularly blessed to spend the first year of her great-grandson Ezra Henri Schlottmann's life with him.

Teresa's passion extended beyond her family to her work as a nutritional specialist, where she served with dedication in various preschools and hospital systems. Her commitment to serving others was further evidenced by her co-leading a Christian servicemen's center in Germany and pastoring with her husband in Hoquiam, WA.

A gifted cook, baker, knitter, and seamstress, Teresa also took great pleasure in her garden, canning and preserving the bounty she grew. Her talents were not limited to her home; she was an accomplished pianist and singer, participating in church worship bands and teen talent competitions throughout her life.

Teresa's faith in Jesus Christ was the cornerstone of her existence, guiding her decisions and actions. She was a fun, loving, and occasionally bossy (in the most endearing way) sister to her seven siblings: Kevin, Bill, Debra, Cynthia (preceded by in death), Gwen, Shelby, and Robin, who remember her as a great listener and advisor.

A memorial service to celebrate Teresa's life will be held on Saturday, March 2, 2024, at the Oakwood Church of God, 4200 Main Street, Oakwood, GA, at 11 AM. Her remains will be laid to rest next to her beloved husband in Tumwater, WA.

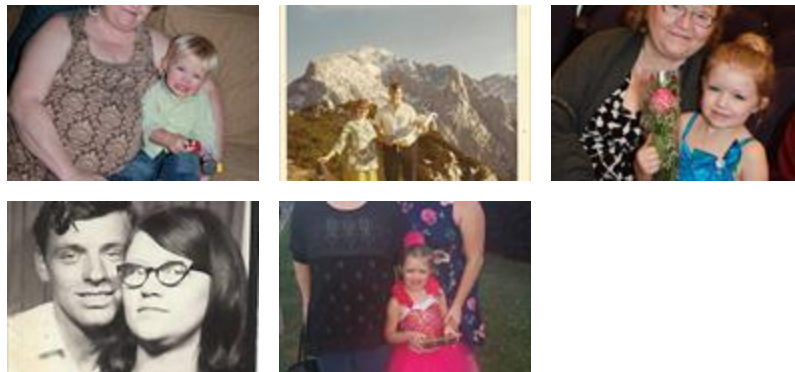

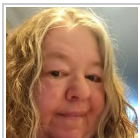

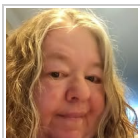
