Vanessa Bryson Beaty, 54, of Lawrenceville, GA passed away Friday, August 5, 2022. She was preceded in death by her father, Jim A. Bryson. Ms. Beaty is survived by her son, Dr. Myles Mason, Lawrenceville, GA; mother, Glenda Maddox Magnes, Lawrenceville, GA; and brother, James “Jim” Bryson of Winder, GA. Aunts, uncles, and numerous cousins also survive. Ms. Beaty was born September 20, 1967 in Atlanta, GA, and was a 1985 graduate of Parkview High School.
