Victor Cox Carbine, age 61, of Buford, GA passed away Wednesday, November 5, 2014 at Northside Forsyth Hospital. Victor coached youth soccer in 1987 and continued to coach t-ball and peewee baseball, basketball and youth football until 1996. For thirty-five years Victor worked for National Steel Company which was sold to Kloeckner Namasco Steel and then Kloeckner Metals Corporation. Victor has been a long-time supporter of Buford Athletics and has cooked hot dogs and hamburgers for the Friday night home football games for fifteen years. He LOVED his Buford Wolves!
