Virginia "Ginny" Holy Morgan of Buford, Georgia passed away peacefully at her home on Thursday, September 29, 2016. Ginny was born July 21, 1953 in Fort Wayne, Indiana and grew up in Atlanta. She attended Lake Side High School and Dekalb Junior College. She worked with her parents, Ruth and Bert Holy at their company, Dillon Manufacturing Company. In 1985, she started an orthopedic supply company, Ginny Incorporated, for Jerome Medical which she later purchased. She was voted Businesswoman of the Year in 2003 by the Business Advisory Council as being one of the top business leaders in the United States. Ginny retired in 2008.

Ginny was a member of Sugar Hill United Methodist Church in Buford serving on various committees over the years and presided over North Gwinnett High School Spirit Club from 2001-2005. An avid golfer and equestrian, Ginny enjoyed annual trips to Fripp Island, South Carolina with her family and friends and loved her life with her family on Lake Lanier. She had a zest for life which was contagious to all who met and knew her and will be dearly missed.
