Zchivago Omar Cannel and his twin, Zchivagla Omarra Cannellyn Swain, were born on April 17th, 1973, to proud parents Paula Louise Brown (deceased) and Bishop Cannel Francis Swain, at the Princess Maragret Hospital, Nassau, Bahamas. The second bundle of joy to grace the Brown clan, Zchivago and Zchivagla stole the hearts of the entire family. They were the little angles who were immensely loved and spoiled by all.

Zchivago or 'Bubba' as he was lovingly called, and Zchivagla, were raised and nurtured in the Anglican faith, where the Brown family were active members. The twins were christened at St. Matthew's, East Shirley Street and confirmed at St. Gregory's, Carmichael Road. It was through his attendance and involvement in church that he accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior at an early age. Before relocating to Atlanta, Georgia, in 1995, Zchivago was a regular parishioner at St. Gregory's Anglican Church. His earthly journey was not easy, but because he knew who he was and whose he was, he was able to put the pieces together and move on with a renewed faith.

Zchivago's education began at St. Mathew's School where he completed both pre and primary schools there.
